Develop your ability to forward-think, plan and develop strategies for organisations across various industries with this Master's course.

COURSE OVERVIEW

On this course, you'll learn what counts as risk and how to manage this within an organisational setting. You'll examine strategic, organisational, environmental and technological risks. You'll explore the varying perceptions of risk, how to prepare for risks and crises, management approaches and techniques and how to lead employees in difficult times.

You'll develop critical thinking and analysis skills that you can use immediately to help organisations prepare for crises.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A second-class honours degree or equivalent professional experience and/or qualifications
- English language proficiency of a minimum of IELTS 6.5 with no component score below 6.0 (or **other acceptable proof**), if English isn't your first language

Applicants who don't have a degree or formal qualifications, but who have appropriate professional experience, may also be considered.

Two years (part time)

THIS COURSE IS DELIVERED ONLINE SO YOU CAN FIT IT AROUND YOUR EXISTING WORK AND PERSONAL COMMITMENTS.

The course content typically includes a mixture of online webinars and learning activities, with further links to additional materials such as multimedia and text articles also provided.

Through our online discussion forums, you'll have access to a global network of students. With them, you can share your perspectives, debate ideas, and talk about current issues in the field. You'll also have the opportunity to interact with your tutors and receive feedback on your work.

All course materials can be accessed through Moodle, our easy-to-use Digital Learning Environment (DLE), anytime, anywhere. All you need is regular access to a computer and an internet connection.

ASSESSMENT

All assessments for the course are based on coursework submitted online. Your performance is assessed through coursework including:

- Written assignments
- A dissertation
