Course overview

Effective leadership is fundamental in the delivery of high-quality healthcare. Leaders in healthcare have a vital role to play in tackling local and global health issues such as the aging population, the burden of disease, changing healthcare systems, and financial austerity.

With this MSc in Healthcare Leadership, you can expect to gain the skills and knowledge required to advance in your career as a clinician, leader, or manager. You'll be taught by our excellent

academic team, with a programme built upon real-world experience in leadership roles.

Your studies will challenge you to reflect on your own practice, personality, and leadership style. By achieving a better understanding of your own approach - combined with the knowledge and evidence which supports high-quality leadership - you will be supported in becoming a more proficient leader and manager.

How you study

This course is offered 100% online, so you don't need to interrupt your work or personal commitments to study. Earn your Masters in just two years and get ahead quicker.

Course content includes an engaging, regularly updated mix of videos, podcasts, and online presentations, with links to further resources and downloadable materials.

Online discussion forums will encourage interaction with your global network of peers, enabling you to share perspectives and debate current topics and issues in your field. You'll also be able to interact with members of the academic team through regular webinars and feedback.

All course content is available online through our easy-to-use, intuitive online learning platform that you can access via desktop or mobile from anywhere, at any time.



Assessment

All assessment for the course is based on coursework and submitted online. There are no exams.

Your performance on the course will be assessed through a range of methods, such as:

- Guided online discussions/activities
- Online lectures and seminars
- Online tutorials
- Critiques and feedback from your tutor
- Critical self-reflection and independent study

Career prospects

This course will allow you to explore and understand leadership in a global context, providing you with an education that can be applied to all healthcare systems and settings.

Upon earning your degree, you will be well-positioned to make exciting new strides in your career. With expertise that holds relevance to disciplines across healthcare, you'll have excellent scope for professional advancement.

Entry requirements

- A minimum **2.2 Honours degree** or [international equivalent](#), ideally in a subject related to health or social care.
- If you don't have a 2.2 Honours degree or international equivalent in a related subject, equivalent **professional qualifications/ personal experience** may be considered.
- Such applicants will need to provide evidence of ability by submitting a 500-word essay that explores - with reference to published evidence - the importance of effective leadership in healthcare.
- One professional or academic reference.
- An IELTS 6.0 score (with minimum 5.5 in each skill) if your first language isn't English (or [other English language proficiency qualifications accepted by the University of Hull](#)).

Alternative programmes

We also offer a Postgraduate Certificate (PgCert) and Postgraduate Diploma (PgDip) in Healthcare Leadership for applicants who may not feel ready to commit to a full Masters.

Students undertaking the PgCert or PgDip can choose to transfer onto the full MSc should they wish to do so, following the successful completion of their studies.

Fees and funding

- MSc course fee: **£10,500**
- PGDip course fee: **£7,000**
- PGCert course fee: **£3,500**

Please note that after securing an offer, you will need to pay a £250 acceptance fee to secure your place.

Payment can be made in full prior to commencing the course, or in 6 instalments over the duration of the course.

Financing your studies

As a University of Hull Online student, you might be eligible for a range of funding and bursaries towards your course fees. UK postgraduate students can apply for a government-backed, non-means-tested loan.

You may also be able to take advantage of the following:

- Bursary: Cash help of up to £400 when you apply (must include a statement explaining how a bursary would help you financially).
- Refer-a-Friend: Any student who refers another student to the University of Hull Online is eligible to receive a £400 reduction in fees. The referred student will also enjoy the same fee reduction.
