Assessment

All assessment for the course is based on coursework and submitted online. There are no exams.

Your performance on the course will be assessed through a range of methods, such as:

- Guided online discussions
- Practical work such as presentations and debates
- Written work such as reports and essays
- Visual work such as infographics and posters
- Critiques and feedback from your tutor

Career prospects

This course will support you in developing an effective, evidence-based approach to teaching and learning that will enhance your capabilities as an educator and help you support those around you.

Upon earning your degree, you'll be well-equipped to innovate in your role and even progress into leader or management positions if that's of interest to you. Crucially, you'll gain the self-direction and time management skills needed to continuously rise to the evolving needs of your specific field.

Entry requirements

- A minimum **2.2 Honours degree or international equivalent**, ideally in a subject related to education.
- If you don't have a 2.2 Honours degree or international equivalent in a related subject, equivalent **professional qualifications/ personal experience** will also be considered.
- Such applicants will need to provide evidence of ability by submitting a 500-word essay that explores - with reference to published evidence - the role of education in society.
- One professional or academic reference.
- An IELTS 6.0 score (with minimum 5.5 in each skill) if your first language isn't English (or other English language proficiency qualifications accepted by the University of Hull).

Fees and funding

Course fee: **£10,000**

(including a £250 acceptance fee)

Payment can be made in full prior to commencing the course, or in 6 instalments over the duration of the course.

Financing your studies

As a University of Hull Online student, you might be eligible for a range of funding and bursaries towards your course fees. UK postgraduate students can apply for a government-backed, non-means-tested loan.

You may also be able to take advantage of the following:

- **Bursary:** Cash help of up to £400 when you apply (must include a statement explaining how a bursary would help you financially).
- **Refer-a-Friend:** Any student who refers another student to the University of Hull Online is eligible to receive a £400 reduction in fees. The referred student will also enjoy the same fee reduction.
